Indoor Air Quality & Contaminant Reduction

Emergency Tips

Mold grows on surfaces like drywall and baseboard dampened by a direct water source or from humid air.

- Moisture control is the key to mold control. When water leaks or spills occur indoors, act quickly to dry wet materials or areas of the building.
- Keep indoor humidity below 60 percent. Use air conditioners and/or dehumidifiers when needed.
- Open windows or use exhaust fans when using the bathroom and kitchen.
- If wet surfaces are dried within 24 to 48 hours after a leak, mold won't grow in most cases.

Dust Mites are tiny bugs you can't see. They live in sheets, blankets, pillows, mattresses, soft furniture, carpets and stuffed toys.

- Wash bed sheets, stuffed toys and blankets once a week. Dry completely.
- Vacuum carpets, rugs and furniture often.
- Clean carpets and air ducts regularly.

Secondhand Smoke can trigger asthma and other serious health problems for children and adults.

- Don't smoke in your home or car.
- Keep family or visitors from smoking in your home.

Cockroach body parts and droppings may trigger asthma attacks.

- Clean dishes, crumbs and spills.
- Store food in air tight containers.

Dogs and Cats A warm-blooded animal's urine and saliva may trigger asthma attacks.

- Keep pets outside if possible.
- If you have indoor pets, keep them out of the bedroom and off the furniture.
- Bathe and groom pets regularly.

Water Damage

- Turn off water source and contact plumber, if repairs are needed.
- If there is no risk of electrical shock, turn off circuit breaker supplying electricity to affected areas.
- Elevate wood and metal furniture to prevent contact with wet floor, using aluminum foil or non-staining wooden blocks.
- Elevate the bottom of draperies and furniture skirts to prevent contact with wet floor coverings.
- Remove shoes, clay pots and printed materials from carpet to prevent color bleed through.
- Contact S.O.S. to perform the water extraction and structural dry down.

Fire and Smoke

- Turn off air conditioner, fan or heater system immediately.
- Change the filter before use if you must use the air conditioning, fan or heating system.
- Do not touch or sit on upholstered furniture.
- Empty refrigerator/freezer of all food if you are without electrical power.
- Secure household from weather, vandals and looters.
- Call S.O.S. to provide structure and content restoration.
